

REGULAR SESSION, COMMON COUNCIL, JANUARY 28, 2013

Be it Remembered that the Common Council of the City of Plymouth, Indiana, met in regular session on January 28, 2013. The meeting was held in the Council Chambers of the City Building, 124 N. Michigan Street, Plymouth, Indiana. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.

Mayor Senter led the Pledge of Allegiance and Councilman Delp offered prayer.

Senter presided for Council Members Delp, Culp, Ecker, Smith and Grobe. Clerk-Treasurer Hutchings, City Engineer Gaul and City Attorney Surrisi were also present.

Councilmen Delp and Ecker moved and seconded to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting on January 14, 2013 and to dispense with reading them since they have been reviewed and found to be correct. The motion carried.

Councilman Delp said that he would be on vacation for the March 25, 2013 meeting. Councilmen Culp and Smith both said they would also be gone.
