

REGULAR SESSION, COMMON COUNCIL, JUNE 22, 2015

Be it Remembered that the Common Council of the City of Plymouth, Indiana, met in regular session on June 22, 2015. The meeting was held in the Council Chambers of the City Building, 124 N. Michigan Street, Plymouth, Indiana. The meeting was called to order at 6:35 p.m.

Mayor Senter led the Pledge of Allegiance and Councilman Delp offered prayer.

Mayor Senter presided for Council Members Delp, Culp, Ecker, Smith, and Grobe. City Attorney Surrisi and Clerk-Treasurer Xaver were also present.

Councilmen Delp and Culp moved and seconded to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting of June 8, 2015, as presented. The motion carried.

Jerry Chavez provided an update regarding Marshall County Economic Development Corporation. After giving a brief description of what the MCEDC offers to our county's businesses, he went on to discuss an application that Marshall, Saint Joseph, and Elkhart counties have come together to submit for a \$40 million grant. This application includes 18 proposed projects with 11 of those being associated with Plymouth. The projects are designed to aid in transforming communities in order to attract capital investment. The application that Marshall, Saint Joseph, and Elkhart counties is developing will be submitted on July 1st. Chavez thanked the Council for their continued support of the MCEDC.

Mayor Senter offered the privilege of the floor to the audience. Gary Cook spoke about the Board of Public Works Proposed Resolution No. 2015-656 stating that upon his retirement from the Plymouth Police Department, the Chief of Police at that time told officers that he had changed policies so that service revolvers could not be purchased by retiring officers. His personal view is that retired Officer Brown should be allowed to purchase his service weapon after serving the community for over 20 years, but he wanted to make sure that the City's policies allowed such a thing to occur.

Councilmen Ecker and Culp moved and seconded to accept the following communications: Minutes of the Board of Public Works and Safety meeting of June 8, 2015; Minutes of the Board of Zoning Appeals meeting of June 2, 2015; Minutes of the Plan Commission meeting of June 2, 2015; Minutes of the Marshall County Council on Aging meeting of May 19, 2015; Minutes of the Redevelopment Commission meeting of May 19, 2015; Minutes of the Redevelopment Commission Special Session of May 27, 2015; Minutes of the Urban Forest and Flower Committee meeting of May 20, 2015; Umbaugh Financial Management Reports for the Plymouth Municipal Wastewater Facility for the four months ended April 30, 2015; Umbaugh Financial Management Reports for the Plymouth Municipal Water Utility for the four months ended April 30, 2015; and Clerk-Treasurer's Cash Reconciliation of May 31, 2015. The motion carried.

There being no further business to discuss, Culp and Delp moved and seconded to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried; the meeting was declared adjourned at 6:51 p.m.
