

REGULAR SESSION, COMMON COUNCIL, AUGUST 8, 2016

Be it Remembered that the Common Council of the City of Plymouth, Indiana, met in regular session on August 8, 2016. The meeting was held in the Council Chambers of the City Building, 124 N. Michigan Street, Plymouth, Indiana. The meeting was called to order at 6:40 p.m.

Mayor Senter led the Pledge of Allegiance and Councilman Delp offered prayer.

Mayor Senter presided for Council Members Cook, Culp, Delp, Ecker, Fonseca, Grobe and Houin. City Attorney Surrisi and Clerk-Treasurer Xaver were also present.

Council Members Delp and Ecker moved and seconded to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting of the Common Council on July 25, 2016, as presented. The motion carried.

Resolution No. 2016-698 was presented. Councilmen Grobe and Culp moved and seconded to approve Resolution 2016-698. The motion carried.

Councilman Delp stated that he is working on getting some answers back on a quote he received for the light post on Ferndale Street. He will discuss this with Street Superintendent Marquardt and provide an update at a later date.

Mayor Senter presented Ordinance No. 2016-2102R, An Ordinance Fixing Salaries of Appointed Officers and Employees, Fire and Police Personnel of the City of Plymouth, Indiana, for the Year 2017, on second reading.

Councilmen Delp and Houin moved and seconded to approve Ordinance No. 2016-2102R, An Ordinance Fixing Salaries of Appointed Officers and Employees, Fire and Police Personnel of the City of Plymouth, Indiana, for the Year 2017, on second reading. There was additional discussion regarding several changes in the ordinance since the last meeting. The motion was defeated on roll call vote.

Clerk-Treasurer Xaver explained that these are not new funds but simply moving already appropriated funds within the Fire Department Fund.

Councilmen Ecker and Grobe moved and seconded to approve Resolution No. 2016-697, A Resolution Providing for the Transfer of Appropriations in the General Fund of the City of Plymouth, Indiana, for the Fire Department as Requested by the Fire Chief and Forwarded to the Common Council for Their Action and Passage Pursuant to IC 6-1.1-18-6. The motion carried.
