

REGULAR SESSION, COMMON COUNCIL, MARCH 30, 2015

Be it Remembered that the Common Council of the City of Plymouth, Indiana, met in regular session on March 30, 2015. The meeting was held in the Council Chambers of the City Building, 124 N. Michigan Street, Plymouth, Indiana. The meeting was called to order at 7:04 p.m.

Mayor Senter led the Pledge of Allegiance and Councilman Delp offered prayer.

Mayor Senter presided for Council Members Delp, Culp, Ecker, Smith, and Grobe. City Attorney Surrisi and Clerk-Treasurer Xaver were also present.

Councilmen Delp and Ecker moved and seconded to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting of March 9, 2015, and to dispense with reading them since they have been reviewed and found to be correct. The motion carried.

Clerk-Treasurer Xaver reported to the council that she has been working with Umbaugh to review proposals from qualified firms specializing in municipal software. The current software was last updated in 2004 and the city needs to move to updated software in order to stay compliant with state and federal mandates. The upgrades were allowed for in the 2015 budget.

City Attorney Surrisi presented Ordinance No. 2015-2086, An Ordinance of the City of Plymouth Authorizing the Issuance of Waterworks Revenue Bonds for the Purpose of Providing Funds to Pay the Cost of Certain Additions, Extensions, and Improvements to the Municipal Waterworks of Said City, Providing for the Safeguarding of the Interests of the Owners of Said Bonds, Other Matters Connected Therewith, Including the Issuance of Notes in Anticipation of Bonds, and Repealing Ordinances Inconsistent Herewith, on first reading.

City Attorney Surrisi also presented Ordinance No. 2015-2087, An Ordinance of the City of Plymouth Authorizing the Current Refunding by the City of its Sewage Works Revenue Bonds of 2008; Authorizing the Issuance of Sewage Works Revenue Bonds for the Purpose of Providing Funds to Pay the Cost of Certain Additions, Extensions and Improvements to the Municipal Sewage Works of the City and Provide for the Refunding; Providing the for the Safeguarding of the Interests of the Owner of Said Bonds, Others Matters Connected Therewith, Including the Issuance of Notes in Anticipation of Bonds, and Repealing Ordinances Inconsistent Herewith, on first reading.

Mayor Senter offered the privilege of the floor to the audience. No one accepted.

Councilmen Ecker and Culp moved and seconded to accept the following communications: Minutes of the Board of Public Works and Safety meeting of March 9, 2015; Minutes of the February 17, 2015 Redevelopment Commission meeting; Minutes of the January 20, 2015 Council on Aging meeting; Minutes of the February 3, 2015 Plan Commission meeting; Minutes of the February 3, 2015 BZA meeting; Minutes of the February 10, 2015 BOAC meeting; Clerk-Treasurer's Depository Statement and Cash Reconciliation for 2/28/15; and Clerk-Treasurer's Memo regarding Conversion of Software. The motion carried.

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There being no further business to discuss, Grobe and Culp moved and seconded to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried; the meeting was declared adjourned at 7:10 p.m.
