

REGULAR SESSION, BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY, JULY 10, 2017

The regularly scheduled Board of Public Works and Safety of Plymouth, Indiana, meeting did not take place because there was not a quorum present.

Several items of business, including opening the bids for Richter Road Water Main Extension, awarding the bid for the ambulance chassis and opening letters of interest for the Hoham Drive Project and the approval of claims were handled by the Common Council.

There is a statutory procedure which states that the time originally advertised to receive bids for a project may be changed if it is in the best interest of the city to do so and that it is announced at the time the original bids were to be opened. The announcement was made at the time of the Board of Public Works and Safety meeting.

Surrisi also announced that the bid opening for the City Hall Renovation Project has been delayed to the July 18th Redevelopment Commission meeting.
