

REGULAR SESSION, COMMON COUNCIL, FEBRUARY 8, 2016

Be it Remembered that the Common Council of the City of Plymouth, Indiana, met in regular session on February 8, 2016. The meeting was held in the Council Chambers of the City Building, 124 N. Michigan Street, Plymouth, Indiana. The meeting was called to order at 6:35 p.m.

Mayor Senter led the Pledge of Allegiance and Councilman Delp offered prayer.

Mayor Senter presided for Council Members Cook, Culp, Delp, Ecker, Fonseca, Grobe and Houin. City Attorney Surrisi and Clerk-Treasurer Xaver were also present.

Councilmen Ecker and Delp moved and seconded to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting of January 25, 2016, as presented. The motion carried.

Randy Danielson presented a 3-minute promotional video entitled "Positively Plymouth". This video will be posted on social media, including Facebook and YouTube, for anyone interested in viewing the video.

City Attorney Surrisi presented Ordinance No. 2016-2097, An Ordinance to Amend the Code of Ordinances of the City of Plymouth Concerning Personnel Policies to Allow for Retiring Fire/EMS Personnel to Purchase their Service Helmet and Boots, on first reading.

City Attorney Surrisi presented Ordinance No. 2016-2098, An Ordinance Adopting the Fee Schedule for the Department of Aviation for the City of Plymouth, on first reading.

City Attorney Surrisi presented Resolution No. 2016-682, A Resolution Providing for the Transfer of Appropriations in the Law Enforcement Continuing Education Fund.

Councilmen Grobe and Delp moved and seconded to approve Resolution No. 2016-682, A Resolution Providing for the Transfer of Appropriations in the Law Enforcement Continuing Education Fund. It passed by roll call vote.

Airport Manager Dave Lattimer provided an update to the Council regarding the Plymouth Municipal Airport's 5-year Capital Improvement plan for 2017 - 2021. Lattimer also provided a large expenditure report for the last 5 years from July 2010 through December 2015.

Clerk-Treasurer Xaver presented an Application for the Exemption from the Licensing Requirements of Ordinance No. 1309 for the Knights of Columbus. The Knights of Columbus is requesting permission to solicit donations at the corner of Michigan and Jefferson Streets on May 6 and May 7, 2016. All proceeds raised will go to the Marshall-Starke Development Center.

Councilmen Ecker and Grobe moved and seconded to approve the request. The motion carried.

Mayor Senter noted that on February 22, 2016, he will be giving his 9th State of the City address to this Council.

Councilmen Ecker and Delp moved and seconded to accept the following communications: Minutes of the Board of Public Works and Safety meeting of January 25, 2016; Minutes of the Downtown Revitalization meeting of January 13, 2016; Minutes of the Redevelopment Commission meeting of January 26, 2016; Minutes of the Technical Review Committee meeting of February 2, 2016. The motion carried.

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There being no further business to discuss, Councilmen Delp and Grobe moved and seconded to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried. The meeting was declared adjourned at 6:55 p.m.
