

REGULAR SESSION, COMMON COUNCIL, SEPTEMBER 24, 2018

Be it Remembered that the Common Council of the City of Plymouth, Indiana, met in regular session on September 24, 2018. The meeting was held in the meeting room of the Plymouth Fire Department, 111 N. Center St., Plymouth, IN. The meeting was called to order at 6:56 p.m.

Mayor Senter led the Pledge of Allegiance and Council Member Ecker offered prayer.

Mayor Senter presided for Council Members Cook, Culp, Ecker, Houin, Longanecker, Milner and Walters. City Attorney Surrisi and Clerk-Treasurer Xaver were also present.

Council Members Longanecker and Culp moved and seconded to approve the minutes of the last regular Common Council meeting on September 10, 2018. The motion carried.

City Attorney Surrisi presented Ordinance No. 2018-2140, An Ordinance for Appropriations and Tax Rates for 2019, on second reading.

Council Members Cook and Milner moved and seconded to adopt Ordinance No. 2018-2140, An Ordinance for Appropriations and Tax Rates for 2019, on second reading. It passed by roll call vote.

Utility Superintendent Davidson explained that this is to cover replacement storm sewers in front of Pregis. There was some damage to the sewers while Comcast was conducting some work in that area.

Council Members Ecker and Milner moved and seconded to adopt Resolution No. 2018-815, A Resolution Providing for the Transfer of Appropriations in the General Fund of the City of Plymouth,

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Indiana as Requested by the Storm Sewer Superintendent and Forwarded to the Common Council for Their Action and Passage Pursuant to IC 6-1.1-18-6. It passed by roll call vote.
