

REGULAR SESSION, COMMON COUNCIL, SEPTEMBER 22, 2014

Be it Remembered that the Common Council of the City of Plymouth, Indiana, met in regular session on September 22, 2014. The meeting was held in the Council Chambers of the City Building, 124 N. Michigan Street, Plymouth, Indiana. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.

Mayor Senter led the Pledge of Allegiance and Councilman Delp offered prayer.

Mayor Senter presided for Council Members Delp, Culp, Ecker, Smith and Grobe. City Engineer Gaul, City Attorney Surrisi and Clerk-Treasurer Hutchings were also present.

Councilmen Delp and Ecker moved and seconded to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting of September 8, 2014, and to dispense with reading them since they have been reviewed and found to be correct. The motion carried.

City Attorney Surrisi presented Ordinance No. 2014-2081, the 2015 Budget Ordinance, on second reading.

Councilmen Ecker and Smith moved and seconded to approve Ordinance 2014-2081, the 2015 Budget Ordinance, on second reading. It passed by roll call vote.

Councilmen Delp and Ecker moved and seconded to approve Ordinance 2014-2081, the 2015 Budget Ordinance, on third reading. It passed by roll call vote.

City Attorney Surrisi presented Ordinance No. 2014-2082, An Ordinance to Amend the Code of Ordinances of the City of Plymouth Concerning Removal of Remaining Code References to the Water Works Board of Trustees and the Sanitary Board of Trustees and to Replace and Amend Presently Effective Code Sections Concerning Water that were Inadvertently Omitted During a Prior Codification, on first reading. He noted that there will be a few revisions to this that will be included in the members' packets for the next meeting, after review by Superintendent Davidson.

It was noted that an Application for the Exemption from the Licensing Requirements of Ordinance 1309, for a Benefit at the VFW for Robert Wallace Sr. had been filed with the clerk-treasurer's office, but was not needed.

Clerk-Treasurer Hutchings presented an Application for the Exemption from the Licensing Requirements of Ordinance 1309, for the Volunteer Fire Department Boot Drive for Ounce of Prevention on Saturday, October 4, 2014 at the intersection of Jefferson and Michigan Streets.

Councilmen Ecker and Grobe moved and seconded to approve the application as presented. It passed by roll call vote.

Mayor Senter offered the privilege of the floor to members in the audience.

Mayor Senter read a Proclamation in honor of Clerk-Treasurer Toni L. Hutchings.

Councilman Smith also praised Hutchings.

Audience Member Wilson Gerrard thanked Hutchings for her service.

Councilmen Ecker and Delp moved and seconded to accept the following communications: minutes of the Board of Public Works and Safety meeting of September 8, 2014; minutes of the Board of Aviation Commissioners meeting of August 12, 2014; minutes of the Redevelopment Commission

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meeting of August 19, 2014; and the minutes of the Urban Forestry and Flower Committee meeting of September 17, 2014. The motion carried.

Hutchings noted that the mayor and councilmen had in front of them a copy of the Redevelopment Commission report that had to be submitted on Gateway by October 1st and presented to the council.

There being no further business to discuss, Councilmen Delp and Grobe moved and seconded to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried; the meeting was declared adjourned at 6:40 p.m.
