

REGULAR SESSION, COMMON COUNCIL, JANUARY 9, 2017

Be it Remembered that the Common Council of the City of Plymouth, Indiana, met in regular session on January 9, 2017. The meeting was held in the Council Chambers of the City Building, 124 N. Michigan Street, Plymouth, Indiana. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.

Mayor Senter led the Pledge of Allegiance and Council Member Ecker offered prayer.

Mayor Senter presided for Councilmembers Cook, Culp, Ecker, Fonseca, Grobe, Houin and Walters. City Attorney Surrisi and Clerk-Treasurer Xaver were also present.

Councilmembers Ecker and Culp moved and seconded to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting of the Common Council on December 27, 2016 as presented. The motion carried.
