

REGULAR SESSION, COMMON COUNCIL, JULY 9, 2018

Be it Remembered that the Common Council of the City of Plymouth, Indiana, met in regular session on July 9, 2018. The meeting was held in the meeting room of the Plymouth Fire Department, 111 N. Center St., Plymouth, IN. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.

Mayor Senter led the Pledge of Allegiance and Council Member Ecker offered prayer.

Mayor Senter presided for Council Members Culp, Ecker, Houin, Longanecker, Milner and Walters. City Attorney Surrisi and Clerk-Treasurer Xaver were also present. Council Member Cook was absent.

Council Members Culp and Ecker moved and seconded to approve the minutes of the last regular Common Council meeting on June 25, 2018, as presented. The motion carried.

Mayor Senter informed the Council that Wednesday, July 18, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. they will be having the ground breaking ceremony for the Aquatics Center. Invitations will be sent out via e-mail.

City Attorney Surrisi reviewed Ordinance No. 2018-2138R, An Ordinance Regarding Various Fees for the City of Plymouth to be presented for vote at the next meeting. Councilman Ecker noted that there should be incremental changes every couple of years instead of having large increases after many years.

Houin and Ecker moved and seconded to table Ordinance No. 2018-2138R. Motion carried.

Mayor Senter informed the Council that there will be budget hearings for the department heads Tuesday, July 10, 2018 at 8:00 a.m. at the Plymouth Fire Department.
