

REGULAR SESSION, COMMON COUNCIL, JANUARY 25, 2016

Be it Remembered that the Common Council of the City of Plymouth, Indiana, met in regular session on January 25, 2016. The meeting was held in the Council Chambers of the City Building, 124 N. Michigan Street, Plymouth, Indiana. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.

Mayor Senter led the Pledge of Allegiance and Councilman Delp offered prayer.

Mayor Senter presided for Council Members Cook, Culp, Delp, Ecker, and Grobe. City Attorney Surrisi and Clerk-Treasurer Xaver were also present. Council Member Fonseca was absent.

Councilmen Delp and Ecker moved and seconded to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting of January 11, 2016, as presented. The motion carried.

Councilman Cook recommended that the City amend the ordinance or resolution that allows retiring police officers to purchase their handgun for \$1.00 to also allow retiring firefighters and paramedics the option of purchasing their helmet and boots at a cost of \$1.00.

Mayor Senter offered the privilege of the floor. Wilson Gerrard suggested the City begin annexing everyone in the two mile zone.

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Councilmen Ecker and Delp moved and seconded to accept the following communications: Minutes of the Board of Public Works and Safety meeting of January 11, 2016; List of Outstanding Unpaid Warrants from 2013 to be Cancelled; Minutes of the Redevelopment Commission meeting of December 15, 2015; Minutes of the Board of Zoning Appeals meeting of January 5, 2016; Minutes of the Technical Review Committee meeting of January 19, 2016. The motion carried.

There being no further business to discuss, Members Delp and Culp moved and seconded to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried. The meeting was declared adjourned at 6:38 p.m.
