

REGULAR SESSION, COMMON COUNCIL, MAY 11, 2020

Be it remembered that the Common Council of the City of Plymouth, Indiana, met in regular session on May 11, 2020. The meeting was held in the Council Chambers, on the second floor of the City Building, 124 N. Michigan St., Plymouth, Indiana and was called to order at 6:30 p.m.

Mayor Senter led the Pledge of Allegiance and Councilman Ecker offered prayer.

Senter presided for Council Members Greg Compton, Duane Culp, Don Ecker, Randy Longanecker, and Shiloh Milner. As allowed by Governor Holcomb's Executive Orders #20-04 and 20-09, Council Members Jeff Houin and Robert Listenberger attended the meeting electronically. City Attorney Sean Surrisi and Clerk-Treasurer Jeanine Xaver were also present.

Members Ecker and Culp moved and seconded to approve the minutes of the regular Common Council meeting on April 27, 2020 as presented. The motion carried.

City Attorney Surrisi updated the council on the Stellar Communities Grant. The Stellar Committee submitted and was awarded \$150,000 from the Community Development Block grant that will be used towards the installation of electronic message boards in each community. These will help citizens get information regarding COVID-19, community events, and other important messages to keep citizens informed.
