

Be it Remembered that the Common Council of the City of Plymouth, Indiana, met in regular session on October 27, 2014. The meeting was held in the Council Chambers of the City Building, 124 N. Michigan Street, Plymouth, Indiana. The meeting was called to order at 7:52 p.m.

Mayor Senter led the Pledge of Allegiance and Councilman Delp offered prayer.

Mayor Senter presided for Council Members Delp, Culp, Ecker, Smith and Grobe. City Engineer Gaul, City Attorney Surrisi and Clerk-Treasurer Xaver were also present.

Councilmen Delp and Ecker moved and seconded to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting of October 13, 2014, and to dispense with reading them since they have been reviewed and found to be correct. The motion carried.

Councilmen Grobe and Ecker moved and seconded to open the public hearing. The motion carried.

City Attorney Surrisi explained that this is addressed in Indiana Code 6-1.1-17-20.3 and requires the city council to have a step in this appropriations hearing.

Susie Reinhold said that the Library Improvement Reserve fund currently has no money appropriated, and she is asking to have funds appropriated in that fund for roof repairs and HVAC work. She said that the Department of Local Government Finance said that because the city council passed the resolution in 1911 to start the library they are the ones that have to approve the additional appropriation.

Councilmen Smith and Delp moved and seconded to close the public hearing. The motion carried.

City Attorney Surrisi presented Resolution No. 2014-633, Additional Appropriations Resolution.

Councilmen Ecker and Culp moved and seconded to adopt Resolution No. 2014-633, Additional Appropriations Resolution. It passed by roll call vote.

Clerk-Treasurer Xaver asked the council to accept a donation from Stockberger Trucking LLC for the fire department. She said that Stockberger Trucking sent a check to the fire department in the amount of \$900 and that Ordinance No. 2003-1834, An Ordinance Establishing a Fund for Monetary Gifts to the City requires that the donations be accepted by the Common Council.

Councilmen Smith and Delp moved and seconded to accept the donation. The motion carried.
