

REGULAR SESSION, COMMON COUNCIL, JULY 13, 2015

Be it Remembered that the Common Council of the City of Plymouth, Indiana, met in regular session on July 13, 2015. The meeting was held in the Council Chambers of the City Building, 124 N. Michigan Street, Plymouth, Indiana. The meeting was called to order at 6:45 p.m.

Mayor Senter led the Pledge of Allegiance and Councilman Delp offered prayer.

Mayor Senter presided for Council Members Delp, Culp, and Ecker. City Attorney Surrisi and Clerk-Treasurer Xaver were also present. Councilmen Grobe and Smith were absent.

Councilmen Delp and Ecker moved and seconded to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting of June 22, 2015, as presented. The motion carried.

City Attorney Surrisi presented Ordinance No. 2015-2088, An Ordinance to Amend the Code of Ordinances of the City of Plymouth Concerning Personnel Policies to Allow for Retiring Police Officers to Purchase Their Service Handgun, on first reading. Due to not having two thirds of the Council present for the vote, further action regarding this ordinance must wait.

City Attorney Surrisi presented Resolution No. 2015-657, A Resolution of the Common Council of the City of Plymouth to Approve the Application of Eugene (Rocky) Talcott for a Commercial Revitalization Rebate Program Grant at 116 N. Michigan Street.

Mr. Talcott was present to discuss his project. He plans to paint the front of the building, install new awnings in the front, install a new roof on both levels, and install new gutters. The painting and awning will be the first portion of the project, with the lowest quotes totaling \$7,806.37 (\$3,622.00 for the painting and \$4,184.37 for the awning). The roof and gutters are awaiting additional quotes before proceeding. The Council is being asked to cover 20% of the cost of the projects, which would be \$1,561.27 for the painting and awning. It was suggested to break the projects up into two sections so Mr. Talcott can proceed as soon as possible.

Councilmen Delp and Ecker moved and seconded to approve the exterior work, the painting and the awning portions, at this point in time. The motion carried by roll call:

The motion carried.

Mayor Senter announced that the budget work session will take place on Monday, August 3, 2015 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers.

There being no further business to discuss, Culp and Delp moved and seconded to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried; the meeting was declared adjourned at 6:53 p.m.
